# Membership

Note that we did not admit the full 340 for the year 2014-5 because of membership issues, reducing revenues significantly.

If member has not played after December 31<sup>st</sup> eligible for pro-rated refund. If played after December 31<sup>st</sup> requires Board decision.

## Building/renovation – meeting scheduled for April 16 – planning

Display panels will be displayed in clubhouse this week

City officials including Doug Pladsen met with Steve, Ken and John last week. The issues include:

- Regulations re accessible washrooms are changing significantly in the next several years so we have to comply
- Park and parking will be a mess during construction

- Connections to sewer and water city will pay to our "lot line", we pay within the club area.
- What kind of permits are required under discussion with City?
- ATC may be eligible for an Ontario Community grant as well as Trillium (for accessible washrooms)

Meeting scheduled at Holy Rosary School for Thursday April 16<sup>th</sup>. A "Pre-read" with relevant information to be posted to Website this weekend.2 weeks prior to meeting.

Motion will be sought from members asking: "Are you willing to allow us to go ahead and get working drawings with costs"?

## Other Issues:

Advertising on website – both on court booking site as well as "members only" – 2 different fee structures. Ads must be tennis related. Further discussion re fees and mechanisms required.
