NEW BUSINESS

PRESIDENT-Chris Duque

- Halton is moving into phase three July 24 and as such discussion was centred around opening the club according to OTA guidelines for phase three while keeping a safe environment for members and contractors

MOTION

Pending approval from the City of Burlington when Halton moves into phase three of pandemic opening, the ATC will implement stage three which means that we no longer need to have ball sharing, junior and adult programs will be allowed following the recommendations provided by the OTA. - in spite of the extreme heat encountered in the last few weeks there is fairly good progress being made with the renovation. There was a satisfactory site visit meeting conducted July 15, 2020 with building committee members present.
- two change orders were presented. Change Order No. 1 for cost of shoring engineering which is for \$2,160.00 and Change Order No. 2 for removal of asbestos found in window caulking for \$1,326.00. A lively discussion centred around change order no. 2 as it was known that there was asbestos and as such the BOD felt that the contractor should have included this the project quote and therefore would not have been an extra cost. The board appreciates the potential for change orders but feels that they only should apply to unknown issues.

MOTION by Oliver to accept Change Order No. 2, seconded by Malcolm and all were in favour

ACTION:

- Oliver to forward Change Orders to both Derek Shrubsole and Lloyd Rapini
- Oliver to let Alto Mar know to proceed with change orders. He will also express the BOD’s concerns around Change Order No 2 as it was a known issue.
